Painted in Buenos Aires-style polychrome, this jaguar ocarina is in a form known as Birmani style, with two tilted

heads, four legs, and a number of perforations to allow for a variety of notes. Expressions on the faces of the jaguar are festive and non-threatening. Many musical instruments were made in animal effigy form, and the qualities associated with the jaguar such as strength, cunning, and power, were traits often honored in ritual musical performances.
